Why? Spearhead the value and increase the visibility and impact of an educational project that serves the beneficiaries of an organization through the creation of an engaging Community of Practice (CoP).

Who? Societies and Colleges, Professional organizations in Ophthalmology designating a Working Group (WG) engaged in creating, advancing and enhancing a project.

One-Two permanent Ophthalmology Foundation (OF) Group Mentors (GM) to facilitate the WG's journey. A WG Co/GM.

How? The project management is illuminated through Group Mentoring that involves Peer Mentoring, Group Facilitation and Co-Mentoring to facilitate the WG in creating their own virtual CoP to scaffold the project development and future follow up.

The virtual CoP sense of ownership mindset is fundamental for the project development. The framework to use follows the Logic Model or similar to guide the flow and monitorization of the project.

The OF GM facilitates the collaborative project advance by connecting and enabling the WG to bridge with sponsor and or partner individuals and organizations, as well as with enduring resources as deemed needed.

Where? By-monthly online meetings. One optional onsite encounter. A social network platform online closed-group to enact permanent communication, exchange of information and materials, and nurture constructive relationships and team building.

When? In segments of 1 year with outputs and outcomes measurement.
